Effectual Fervent Prayer, Part 1 - Jubilee Prayer

<u>James 5:16</u> Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The <u>effectual fervent prayer</u> of a righteous man availeth much.

<u>Matthew 17:20-21</u> And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have <u>faith</u> as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. Howbeit this kind goeth not out <u>but by prayer and fasting</u>.

- The Hebrew word for FASTING means "to cover the mouth"
- The Greek word for FASTING means "to abstain"

DANIEL FAST:

- A partial fast
- Water and juices to drink, fruits and vegetables to eat
- Pulse = "something sown" (things from seed)

<u>Daniel 1:12</u> Prove thy servants, I beseech thee, ten days; and let them give us pulse to eat, and water to drink.

<u>Daniel 10:1-3</u> In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a thing was revealed unto Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar; <u>and the thing was true</u>, <u>but the time appointed was long</u>: and he understood the thing, and had understanding of the vision. In those days I Daniel was mourning <u>three full</u> <u>weeks</u>. I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till <u>three whole weeks</u> were fulfilled.

<u>Daniel 10:12-13</u> Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for <u>from the first day</u> that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words. But the prince of the kingdom of Persia <u>withstood me one and twenty days</u>: but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of Persia.

2 Corinthians 10:3-4 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

Leviticus 25:9-10 Then shalt thou cause the <u>trumpet of the jubile</u> to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month, in the day of atonement shall ye make the trumpet sound throughout all your land. And ye shall <u>hallow the fiftieth year</u>, and <u>proclaim liberty</u> throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof: it shall be a jubile unto you; and ye shall <u>return</u>

<u>every man unto his possession</u>, and ye shall <u>return every man unto his</u> family.

We have a special reason to begin this year with prayer and fasting!

Isaiah 58:1-3 Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and shew my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins. Yet they seek me daily, and delight to know my ways, as a nation that did righteousness, and forsook not the ordinance of their God: they ask of me the ordinances of justice; they take delight in approaching to God. Wherefore have we fasted, say they, and thou seest not? wherefore have we afflicted our soul, and thou takest no knowledge? Behold, in the day of your fast ye find pleasure, and exact all your labours.

Isaiah 58:5-6 Is it such a fast that I have chosen? a day for a man to afflict his soul? is it to bow down his head as a bulrush, and to spread sackcloth and ashes under him? wilt thou call this a fast, and an acceptable day to the Lord? Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

<u>Isaiah 58:12</u> And they that shall be of thee shall <u>build the old waste</u> <u>place</u>s: thou shalt <u>raise up the foundations of many generations</u>; and thou shalt be called, <u>The repairer of the breach</u>, <u>The restorer of paths to dwell in.</u>

<u>Joel 2:12-15</u> Therefore also now, saith the Lord, turn ye even to me with all your heart, and with <u>fasting</u>, and with weeping, and with mourning: And <u>rend your heart</u>, and not your garments, and turn unto the Lord your God: for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil. Who knoweth if he will return and repent, and leave a blessing behind him; even a meat offering and a drink offering unto the Lord your God? <u>Blow the trumpet in Zion</u>, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly:

<u>Joel 2:28</u> And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:

We Gentiles are in the church in the first place because of fasting!

Acts 10:28-31 And he said unto them, Ye know how that it is an unlawful thing for a man that is a Jew to keep company, or come unto one of another nation; but God hath shewed me that I should not call any man common or unclean. Therefore came I unto you without gainsaying, as soon as I was sent for: I ask therefore for what intent ye have sent for me? And Cornelius said, Four days ago I was fasting until this hour; and at the ninth hour I prayed in my house, and, behold, a man stood before

me in bright clothing, And said, <u>Cornelius, thy prayer is heard</u>, and thine alms are had in remembrance in the sight of God.
