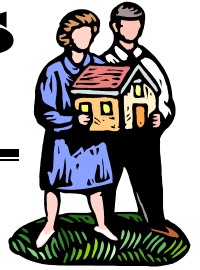

## Habit 5: Respect Your Heritage

*Sunday, June 25, 2000*

**Exodus 20:12 (NLT)** <sup>12</sup> Honor your father and mother. Then you will live a long, full life in the land the LORD your God will give you.

- The first four commandments have to do with our \_\_\_\_\_ relationship with God.

## HOW SHOULD I HONOR MY PARENTS?

- **Ephesians 6:1-3 (LB)** <sup>1</sup> Children, obey your parents; this is the right thing to do because God has placed them in authority over you. <sup>2</sup> Honor your father and mother. This is the first of God's Ten Commandments that ends with a promise. <sup>3</sup> And this is the promise: that if you honor your father and mother, yours will be a long life, full of blessing.
- Part of the loving obligation of a parent is \_\_\_\_\_, which requires instruction, reinforcement and punishment.
- **Proverbs 13:24 (NLT)** If you refuse to discipline your children, it proves you don't love them; if you love your children, you will be prompt to discipline them.
- **Proverbs 19:18 (NLT)** Discipline your children while there is hope. If you don't, you will ruin their lives.
- **Proverbs 15:5 (NLT)** Only a fool despises a parent's discipline; whoever learns from correction is wise.
- **Proverbs 22:15 (NLT)** A youngster's heart is filled with foolishness, but discipline will drive it away.

2. As a young person, I honor my parents by \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ them.

  - **1 Timothy 5:8 (LB)** Anyone who won't care for his own relatives when they need help, especially his own family, has no right to say he is a Christian. Such a person is worse than the heathen.
  - **1 Timothy 5:4 (NLT)** Their first responsibility is to show godliness at home and repay their parents by taking care of them. This is something that pleases God very much.
