- WITNESS: In the NT the original notion of a witness is exhibited in the special form of one who attests his belief in the gospel by personal suffering. Hence it is that the use of the ecclesiastical term "martyr" has arisen. (Unger's Bible Dictionary, page 1369)
- The word "witness" comes from the Greek word "martureo" which means to "testify."

Luke 24:48 And ye are witnesses of these things.


## The River of Revival
