o SOWING vs. REAPING : Peter Joel's prophecy to show that the visions of the young will step to the forefront, supported by the dreams of the elders.
 DREAM: from the Hebrew root CHALAM, which also means "to restore to health, to be strong, to be healthy" Dreams have to do with the Our dream is our, which has to stay "strong and healthy"
 VISION: from the Hebrew root CHAZAH, which also means "to perceive with the intelligence, to see by experience" Visions have to do with the
