**Romans 7:20-24** Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me. For I delight in the law of God after the inward man: But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

## TWO LAWS

- We have \_\_\_\_\_ from sin's dominion, which gives us the power to \_\_\_\_\_ not to sin.

**John 8:36** If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

- We will not \_\_\_\_\_ to live in sin, and in fact our new nature \_\_\_\_\_ live in sin.

**1 John 3:9** Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

- Our old nature is not \_\_\_\_\_ but merely \_\_\_\_\_ within us, so our flesh still has the ability to commit sinful acts.

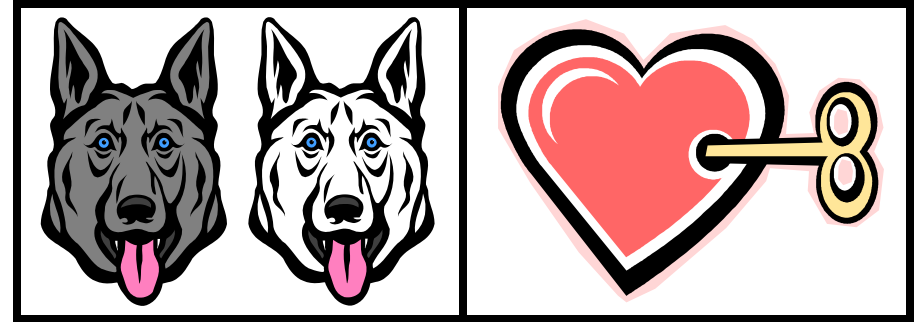
**1 John 2:1** My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

**Galatians 5:16** This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.
