DREAM: from the Hebrew root CHALAM, which also means "to restore to health, to be strong, to be healthy"

VISION: from the Hebrew root CHAZAH, which also means "to perceive with the intelligence, to see by experience"

- **Proverbs 29:18 (KJV)** Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he.
- **Proverbs 29:18 (NKJV)** Where there is no revelation, the people cast off restraint; But happy is he who keeps the law.
- **Proverbs 29:18 (MES)** If people can't see what God is doing, they stumble all over themselves; But when they attend to what he reveals, they are most blessed.
